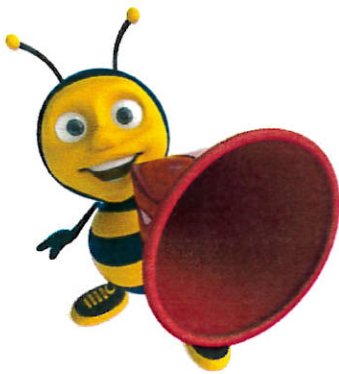


Greenwich Township School District Summer Enrichment

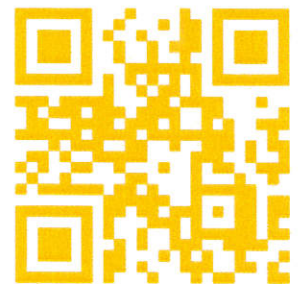
